

Court Ordered Article 10 Removals

Report Background To allow districts to meet their required search for Court Ordered Article 10 removals. This report is part of the “Division of Child Care Services” report series.

Report Purpose This report uses the Division of Child Care Services package. Local Districts, Regional Office and OCFS State Staff will have access to this report. The report can be saved in excel or PDF format to share with those who do not have access to this report.

Prompts The user has the option of searching for a Case Name or a specific Case ID. These prompts are optional, but can be used to narrow down the list of information returned in the report

Notes This report contains a filter of **(activity code equal to L700 with a modifier A of 27 or 28) or (activity code of L300 with a modifier A of 04, 05 or 21 and a modifier B or C of 43, 44, 62, 64, 68, 88 or 89)**. This report contains a drill through on Case ID to a listing of the case composition. The drill through report contains demographic information for all those individuals associated with the case.

Data Item	Data Definition
Case ID	Most recently assigned Case ID. This number is assigned by the district or agency and is not unique statewide.
Case Name	The name by which the child's case is currently identified (usually Line 1 of the WMS application)
WMS Case Status	A descriptive decode which indicates the current status of the WMS case.
County	The name of the district currently controlling the CCRS case.
Line No	The line number of the CCRS application on which the individual appears.
DOB	Date of birth of the individual
Gender	Gender of the individual
Ethnicity	Identifies racial origin of the individual
Activity Date	Date on which the legal activity occurred
Legal Activity	The four character CCRS legal activity code; see Notes above and/or consult your CCRS Coding Guide

Data Item	Data Definition
ModA	The Modifier A values that associate specific information for each activity code (i.e., type of legal event); see Notes above and/or consult your CCRS Coding Guide
ModB	The Modifier B values that associate specific information for each activity code (i.e., dispositions); see Notes above and/or consult your CCRS Coding Guide
ModC	The Modifier C values that associate specific information for each activity code (i.e., dispositions); see Notes above and/or consult your CCRS Coding Guide
