This letter is to inform you that the amended child care section found in your Child and Family Services Plan, 2022 Annual Plan Update, was approved and became effective October 1, 2022. This approval reflects the increase in differential rate for homelessness and the increase in differential rate for non-traditional hours.

Appendix T: Transportation, Differential Payment Rates, Enhanced Market Rates for Legally Exempt Providers, and Sleep:

- NYC ACS requests to increase the differential rate for Homelessness: Licensed and Registered Providers from 5% to 15% retroactive to October 1, 2022.
- NYC ACS requests to increase the differential rate for Non-traditional Hours: All Providers from 5% to 15% retroactive to October 1, 2022.
